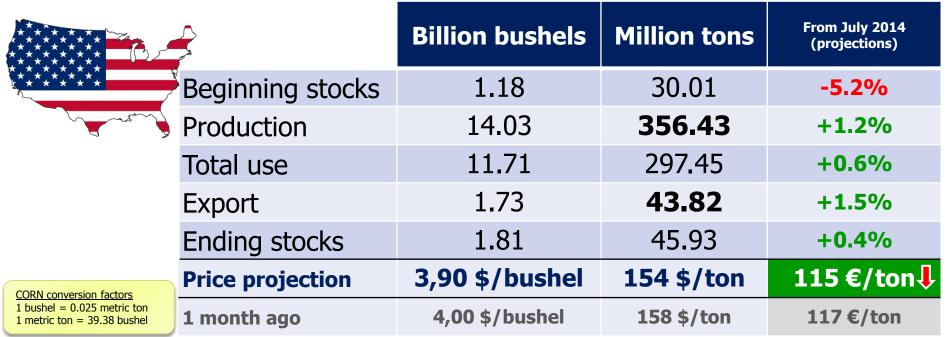
- **Global Corn supplies** for 2014-15 (new marketing year starting September 1st) are projected at **985.39 Mio t**, higher compared to July estimates, reflecting larger expected corn crops in the U.S. and in the E.U..
- In the **United States**, Corn production is expected 4.4 Mio t higher at a record **356.43 Mio t** compared with last month forecast. The **corn yield is projected at 167.4 bushels per acre** (= 10.63 tons/hectare). With the larger crop, projected corn use for 2014-15 for ethanol and exports is higher.
- **European Union** production is raised 1.4 Mio t at **67.05 Mio t**, after abundant rainfall and favorable temperatures during July. Corn consumption is lowered 2 Mio t for EU as heavy summer rains have reduced wheat quality across the region, raising prospects for wheat feeding.



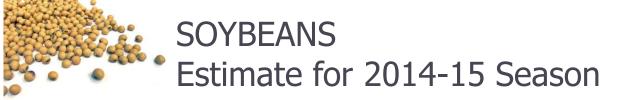

- ▶ Global Soybean production for 2014-15 (new marketing year starting October 1st) is projected at 304.69 Mio t, unchanged from last month.
- Higher Soybean production for the United States is offset by a reduction for India.
- ▶ **U.S.** Soybean production is forecast at **103.85 Mio t**, +16% from July estimates. The Soybean yield forecast is a record 45.4 bushels per acre (=3.09 tons/hectare) and harvested area is forecast at 84.1 Mio acres (=33.64 hectares).
- Lower Soybean production for **India** is due to lower planted area for the delayed monsoon.

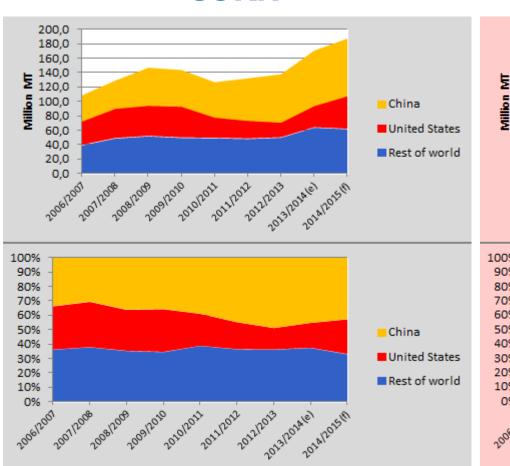

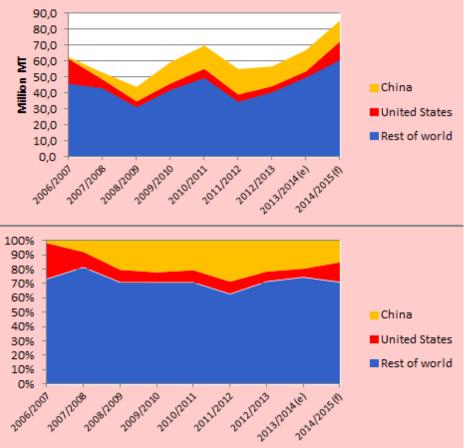

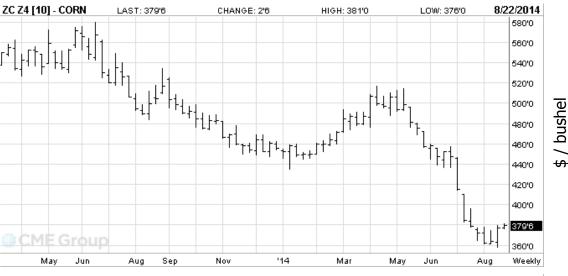

Soybean price trend as listed by the <u>CME</u> <u>of Chicago</u>:



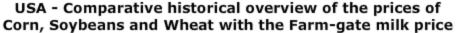

 US – <u>Price comparison</u>: Corn, Soybeans, Wheat and Farm-gate milk price



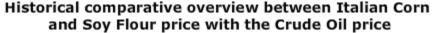


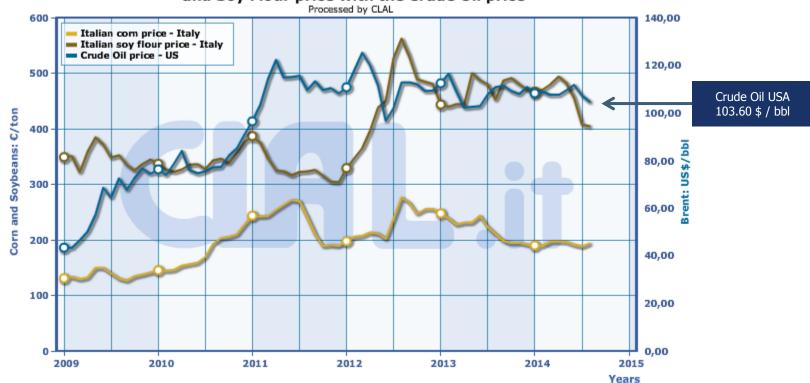

Price comparison: Corn (Italy), Soy flour (Italy) and Crude Oil (US)

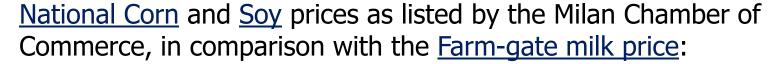
